Dear School Community/Staff/Students,

On September 24, 2016 our school district tested all potable water sources in every building for lead contamination as required by New York State Public Health Laws. The results of that testing were received on October 18, 2016 and indicated that out of the 66 water samples tested only one source showed lead levels above the 15 parts per billion (ppb) threshold. This source was a seldom-used hand wash sink in the elementary school kitchen that originally tested at 23 ppb. This source was re-tested, and the results were received by our district on December 6th showing that the lead levels are now 3.7 ppb – well below the 15 ppb threshold.

I am pleased to report that we have no other issues with our water. However, should you have questions, please contact me at 988-3293 ext. 3399.
