

Absentee Ballot Information

The Pine Valley Central School District is required by law to have absentee ballots for the Special Election on December 18, 2018. Applications for absentee ballots for voting on the Capital Improvements Project 2020 may be applied for at the office of the School District Clerk. Any such application must be received by the District Clerk (i) at least seven (7) days before the date of the vote, if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or (ii) the day before such vote, if the ballot is to be picked up personally by the voter.

A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots have been issued will be available for public inspection during regular business hours in the office of the School District Clerk on each of the five (5) days prior to the day of the election except Saturday and Sunday.

Absentee ballots must be received in the office of the School District Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on December 18, 2018.
