PINE VALLEY CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT 2020

Dear Residents of Pine Valley Central School District:

On Tuesday, December 18, 2018 the Pine Valley Central School Board of Education is asking for your support for a 6.5 million dollar facilities improvement project which will result in a **ZERO INCREASE** to your property taxes. The Board of Education has carefully designed this project to address the following areas:

SAFETY, ACCESSIBILITY AND GENERAL MAINTENANCE:

- Total Cost: \$850,000
- Relocate Buildings and Grounds office to the junior/senior high school receiving area
- Relocate Business office across from the superintendent's office and install security door to limit direct access into the elementary building and return existing business office to instructional space
- Install grab bars, mirrors and push buttons on doors (toilet rooms), benches (locker rooms) and viewing positions for wheelchairs (auditorium) for ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) compliance

HEATING, VENTILATION AND AIR CONDITIONING (HVAC) SYSTEMS:

- Total Cost: \$2,950,000
- Replace outdated building controls and air handling units in both the elementary and junior/senior high school

OUTDOOR FIELD USE:

- Total Cost: \$1,400,000
- Regrade the soccer/football field, install drainage and sod
- Install four new LED lights and poles at the soccer/football field
- Provide additional drainage at the varsity baseball field

ENHANCE INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMMING:

- Total Cost: \$1,300,000
- Reconstruct existing CAD Lab, Maker Space, Wood Shop, Paint Room, Dust collector, Maple Processing
- Add Greenhouse-Innovation Lab
