#### <u>Proposition #4 – Snow Removal Equipment Reserve Fund</u>

The ultimate amount of such Fund shall not be greater than \$200,000 plus interest thereon; the probable term of such Fund shall be not later than July 1, 2025; the source of the monies for the Fund shall be the unappropriated fund balance of the District.

Sherry Gruszynski elected to a one-year term (2017-2018) assuming office at the May 18, 2017 Board meeting. (fills the vacancy created by the resignation of Adam Lukasik with this position being re-aligned as a three-year term in the May 2018 election.)

Rex Butcher elected to a one-year term (2017-2018) (fills the vacancy created by the resignation of Nancy Stock.)
